



1 in 40 adults report having
been physically abused as children.

Most children don't tell.



1 in 10 adults report having
been **emotionally** abused as children.



1 in 5 adults report having
been **sexually** abused as children.



1 in 4 adults report having
been **physically** abused as children.

Most children don't tell.



Offenders seek out faith communities.

And yet,



Only 58% of Jewish day schools have a child protection policy.

Nearly 25% of Jewish overnight camps do not require staff to report abuse to governmental authorities.

Fewer than 20% of synagogues offer child protection training to their youth directors.

It's time to change that. Together we can.
